

GUIDELINES ON PROPER ATTIRE FOR ATTENDING CHURCH SCHOOL

When attending the Divine Liturgy or Church School:

1. Please remember short mini-skirts and low cut blouses are not proper attire for worship.
2. Casual or high-fashion clothing such as halter dresses, spaghetti-strap and bare-shouldered dresses or sweatshirts, levis, hip huggers, or shorts should be limited for casual or other appropriate use and not for church attendance.
3. No thongs or sneakers are acceptable.
4. Male students should always wear a dress shirt, turtleneck or a sweater.

Partaking of Holy Communion:

1. All the preceding rules should be observed.
2. Female students who approach the Holy Altar to receive the Sacrament must have a head covering (veils are always available)
3. Female students should remove lipstick before receiving the Sacrament. It is preferable to keep make-up to a modest minimum.
