ASK THE PASTOR

Q. SHOULD THE CONGREGATION SING WITH THE CHOIR?

Yes, they should, but advisedly. The role of the choir in the liturgy is not to perform for the congregation, but to lead them in worship. In Armenian cathedrals and large parishes, the choirs are well rehearsed and often include professional singers. Sometimes it is tempting to think that such choirs, which sing our sacred music so beautifully, are performing for us. We should never think that the congregation's role in worship is that of spectator or audience. In the *Badarak*, the hymns and responses sung by the choir are actually the worshipping congregation's part in the grand sacramental prayer that is the Divine Liturgy. Those who wish to sing should feel free to do so, carefully following the choir director's lead. Those with a real love for our church's music should consider joining the choir and adding their voice to the beautification of the prayer we offer to God.
