

GOSPEL READING: Luke 4:14-23

And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee, and a report concerning him went out through all the surrounding country. And he taught in their synagogues, being glorified by all.

And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up; and he went to the synagogue, as his custom was, on the sabbath day. And he stood up to read; and there was given to him the book of the prophet Isaiah. He opened the book and found the place where it was written, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim release to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord."

And he closed the book, and gave it back to the attendant, and sat down; and the eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on him. And he began to say to them, "Today this scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing." And all spoke well of him, and wondered at the gracious words which proceeded out of his mouth; and they said, "Is not this Joseph's son?" And he said to them, "Doubtless you will quote to me this proverb, 'Physician, heal yourself; what we have heard you did at Capernaum, do here also in your own country.""

THE CREED - What We Believe

This pronfession of faith was agreed upon by all the churches at the first ecumenical council held in 325 AD in the city of Nicea, near Constantinople. The Nicene Creed is solemnly chanted by all the people as an official declaration of the most important articles of the Church's doctrine. It is essential that all those who have assembled for the Divine Liturgy be of one theological mind. If our worship is to be truly the corporate act of Christ's body, the Church, then there can be no diversity of opinion regarding who God is, and who we are relative to Him. This is what the Nicene Creed declares.

While reciting the Creed, the faithful stand facing the altar and join their hands together, thumbs crossed, palms touching, a reminder of our unity in the orthodox faith.

What to teach your children AT HOME this week.

HOW TO GREET THE ORDAINED BISHOPS & PRIESTS

With our Diocesan Primate coming to Detroit on the next weekend, many of our children will have the opportunity to greet him and receive his blessing.

- 1. It is always proper to kiss the hand of Srpazan Hayr when greeting him, for adults and children alike. DO NOT SHAKE HIS HAND.
- 2. You should say to Khajag Srpazan..."Orhnetzek Srpazan Hayr" [Bless Me Your Eminence] and then bend down to receive his blessing and kiss his RIGHT hand. An alternate greeting could be used as well. It is...Asdvadz Oknagan Srpazan Hayr [May God be your helper Your Eminence]
- 3. When greeting other clergymen of differing ranks, say the following:

For a Der Hayr you say, "Orhnetzek Der Hayr" [Bless Me Der Hayr, or Orhnya Der [Bless O Lord].

And for a Hayr Soorp [unmarried priest] you say, "Asdvadz Oknagan Hayr Soorp" [May God Be Your Helper Holy Father].

4. It is proper also to kiss the hand of any priest as a sign of respect and receive the Blessing of Christ that comes from his anointed hand.

WELCOME

We welcome our visitors who are attending the Divine Liturgy at St. John's parish, and we pray that your participation has been enriched through word and worship. We invite those visitors who are baptized and/or confirmed in the Armenian Church or are members of a church which is in communion with the Armenian Church to receive the Sacrament of Holy Communion. If you are a member of the Armenian Church and a newcomer to our community and would like information about our Christian Education program or any of our parish auxiliary groups, please call our office and we will be happy to respond to your questions. The Lord Jesus Christ loves you and desires that you share His love with others, making this holy community your spiritual home.

MARRIAGES

Arrangements for weddings in our holy sanctuary are to be made at least eight months in advance. Marriage preparation and counseling are required before the celebration of the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony. Marriages are NOT celebrated during the season of Great Lent according to Armenian Church Canon Law.

BAPTISMS AND CHRISMATIONS

All Baptisms must be scheduled no less than two months in advance. At least one of the godparents must be a member of the Armenian Church, i.e. baptized in the Armenian Apostolic Orthodox faith. Baptisms are NOT celebrated during the season of Great Lent according to Armenian Church Canon Law.
