

Feast Day of the Holy Saint Sandukht

Saturday, July 17th, the Armenian Church observed the Feast of Saint Thaddeus the Apostle and the Holy Virgin Saint Sandukht. The story of these two saints shed light on the early days of Christianity in Armenia. In 2001, St. John Women's Guild commissioned a beautiful mosaic dedicated to Saint Sandukht which was installed and consecrated in St. John's Holy Sanctuary. To celebrate the feast day honoring Saint Sandukht, the Women's Guild adorned the mosaic with flowers and candles. We ask through prayer that our saint inspire us with her spirit, and to intercede on our behalf with God.

While checking out click on *Add an order note* and type in your instructions such as, "Donation for Picnic Bake Sale," that way your donation will go exactly where you intend.

If you make a mistake scroll up to the shopping cart icon and click 'Remove' next to the item to delete it. That's it!

** NOTE: The version of the website we use is the free one (we pay only when there is a transaction), this has limitations such as not having a fill-in-the-blank option for donations. We hope these suggestions allow our members a viable work-around.
